Ticehurst Neighbourhood Plan

There has been some progress on the "Independent Examination" of the Ticehurst Neighbourhood Plan. As stated previously the Independent Examiner will take all the documentation, including the representations from Regulation 16, and consider whether the plan conforms to the legal requirements for neighbourhood plans.



His initial view is that he should be able to deal with the examination of the Plan without holding a public hearing, but reserves the right to do so. Based on a preliminary consideration there are a small number of matters he wishes to receive further representation from Ticehurst Parish Council (TPC) and Rother District Council (RDC), these are detailed in his initial comments.

In his initial comments he also requested a response from TPC and RDC. The TPC has published its response with 9 associated documents on the TNP website evidence page and the RDC has published its response on their website.

We await the final outcome of this examination.
